Curling Season is literally right around the corner. All our regular leagues will start the week of October 11/22. Now is the time to think curling, as we had our first frost this week and the golf courses are covered in leaves. Get those curling shoes and brushes out and enter your teams this week.

The Club started putting ice in September 19/22 so that we would be ready for the “Women in Curling Summit” on September 24/2022.

We have had to increase fees this year to cover our increasing costs, especially the larger than expected increases in electricity, gas, and the Carbon Tax. The last general increase to fees was 2019. You can however avoid one of the other increases; the 6% PST which will be added on October 1, 2022.

You must pay your fees in full prior to September 30, 2022 to avoid the PST.

FEES ARE DUE BY NOVEMBER 15

AVOID THE PST - *PAY FEES BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30*

6% PST now applies to all curling fees for persons over 18 years of age.

Pay early and avoid the Tax this season.

This is a new event for U15 curlers and a new event for curling in general. The event is open to individual or team registration.

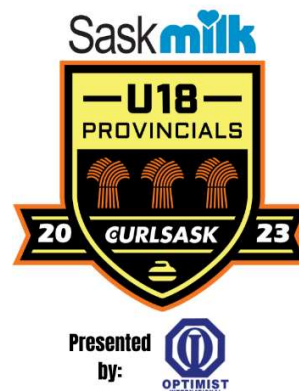
